Information for female prostitutes in Krefeld

The Prostitutes Protection Act has been in effect in Germany since July 1, 2017.

Prostitutes are required to register their work with the authorities.
You do this in the city where you mainly want to work at the following institutions:

1. Health advice:

At the health department, a consultant informs you about STD (sexually transmitted diseases), AIDS and contraception. You also have the opportunity to talk about yourself and your personal situation. Afterwards, you will receive a certificate of the consultation

- You have to submit this to the regulatory authority
- You always have to carry it with you, while you are working.

2. Registration at the regulatory authority

At the regulatory authority, you will receive advice on the rights and obligations of prostitutes. Furthermore, you will get information about what to do in case of an emergency and where to find help.

For the appointment you will need:

- Three passport photos
- Certification of the health department
- A work permit if you are not from the European Union

Then, you will receive a certificate that you have to carry with you while working.

If you are under twenty-one, you will need to renew your registration every year.

If you are older than twenty-one, you need to renew your registration every two years.

Violations of the regulations will be prosecuted.

Voluntary prostitution is allowed in Germany.
